3rd -5th graders participated and the final round will be with NES at GGS on **Thursday June 8th**.



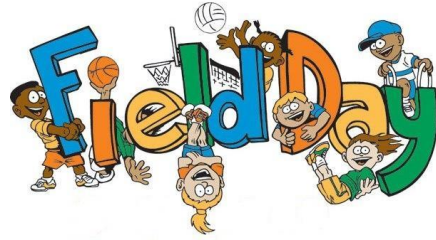
FIELD DAY VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

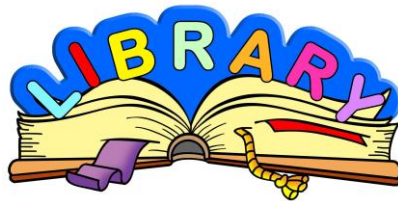
