




#### CLASS SIZE

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
Every student will improve their math and reading fluency towards proficiency, meeting grade level targets or reading at or above 180 wpm. Every student will be safe, responsible, and respectful.

Students who attended more than 90% of their enrolled school days.




Students earning one-quarter of graduation credits in their 9th grade year.

Students earning a high school diploma or GED within five years.




#### **State Goals**




