INTRODUCTION

Overview

A committee made up of community and District representatives was created to come up with recommendations that support efforts to create a culture of appreciation and honor district employees for the exemplary work they do. It is the strongly held belief Neah-Kah-Nie School District employees are worthy of and deserve recognition. The District currently recognizes employees for years of service, a retirement reception, and Licensed and Classified Weeks; however, the committee wants to expand employee recognition at the District level without interrupting the many ways individual schools recognize employees. The result of the committee's work is a comprehensive staff recognition program that is effective and sustainable. *Treasure Awards* was the name chosen for the staff recognition program. Neah-Kah-Nie School District believes employees are *Treasures* that nourish students' minds, develop everlasting positive relationships with students, and are the real hidden jewels of the District. Components of the *Treasure Awards* recognition program include:

- An ongoing Employee Recognition Committee to be an ongoing advocate for staff recognition activities, and continue to research best practices for staff recognition
- An on-line recognition mechanism that allows for simple, frequent recognition of any employee by any employee, community member, students, and parents
- Each trimester, two employees will be recognized with Treasure Awards

The Toolkit

The purpose of this toolkit is to assist in fostering a culture of appreciation within Neah-Kah-Nie School District that honors and acknowledges district employees for the extraordinary work they do. Benefits of utilizing the tool kit include building rapport with employees and co-workers, engaging them, and cultivating a positive climate that people enjoy being a part of. Recognition Guidelines

- · Be inclusive of all District employees
- Be fair and be consistent. Do not play "favorites"
- · Be aware of employee's comfort level with public attention when recognizing them

Tips for Recognizing Employees

- Be timely. Recognize the worker promptly after the achievement
- Be specific in your praise and how the employee made a difference
- Look for the "extras" that people do
- Speak from your heart it will show genuine gratitude and/or appreciation

Where To Recognize an Employee

Physical location can vary based on the method of recognition and comfort level. Some suggestions for face to face recognition include:

- In the classroom
- At a school assembly
- · At a staff meeting
- School board meeting
