  2. What goals or career do you want to pursue after high school? What school do you plan to attend and how will education get you to your goals? 15 points.
  3. Describe your involvement with community organizations during the past 4 years including, but not limited, to unpaid volunteer/nonprofit work or fundraising, or church involvement. Estimate the number of hours spent on each in the past 4 years. 20 points.
  4. Describe your involvement in school extracurricular activities, work for pay, and work at home (farm work, child care, etc.). Estimate the number of hours spent on each in the past 4 years. 20 points
