

Middle School Announcements

Wild West Camp: Middle School 6th graders are invited to a Wild West 4H Camp that will be held July 12-16th this summer. Applications will be sent home and those interested will need to turn them in right away as space is limited. They need to be taken to the 4H office in Tillamook either in person or by mail, NOT turned in to the school. (The directions are on the form).

Track: If you want to participate in track this year, there is a sign-up sheet outside of the office window. Please be sure to check with the office to see if you have all the required paperwork in, or pick it up if you don't. Stay tuned for more information as to when track will begin.

Masks: Outside masks will not be required and are optional. Starting next week, March 14, all masks will be optional! Until then, please wear your mask while in the building.
