## Old business:

<u>Bus driver video</u> to showcase diversity in our district- Michael is currently busy on Mondays, so he may not be able to connect with the drivers who are willing to be interviewed. Michael will ask Michael and Kelly for input on who would be able to supervise the student interviewers and when. There was discussion of other alternatives, such as having an outside person create the video.

The <u>press release</u> was finalized and sent to the superintendent. It was included in the Garibaldi Grade School newsletter. Kelsey Cardwell, ESD Community Director, will be invited to our next meeting so we can discuss this with her present to provide the context for our decision to create this. There may be some questions for us to answer as well, then the press release may be included in the ESD newsletter.

Discussion of the <u>Bullying/Harassment complaint form</u> occurred. It needs to reflect our policies. JFCF and JBB are 2 to look at, there were changes made to Riverdale School Districts in regards to dating policy and intimidation that Liwaru is aware of and thinks we may want to include. ACB is the bias complaint procedure. We will compare these at our next meeting and review the slide show as well to begin work on the complaint form.

<u>Name pronunciations for Native peoples</u>- We have not yet had a response from the Grand Rhonde.

<u>Pride flag incidents</u>- Updates for the student handbook and board policies were briefly discussed but nothing was decided. Callen Sterling, OSBA attorney, stated that this is definitely a bias incident covered by policy ACB, All Students Belong.

New business-

There was a second pride flag incident at NKN.

Cynthia Grelk is now the person to <u>post our meeting dates and minutes</u> on the website. We need to clarify if our meetings are required to be public. Liwaru cited SB 732, which states that they do not need to be public meetings. Superintendent Erlebaach has stated they do need to be open to the public.
