

Welcome back! We are so excited to start the year with your kiddos on the 3rd.

As the school counselor I will be teaching SEL lessons (social emotional learning) 30 minutes a week in each classroom Pre-K through 5th grade. I love getting to connect with students each week. I also work individually with students (not therapy) to help in

cultivating social and emotional skills or provide support during challenging situations.

Additionally, I will be able to provide small group counseling which allows students to practice skills such as self control, friendship, managing emotions and handling worry and stress. In September, our lessons will work on connecting and getting to know each other as well as starting with understanding brain states and self regulation, introducing Kelso's choices (problem solving and conflict resolution) and introducing our Tools that foster empathy, resilience and self-mastery.

If you have any questions or concerns about your student, feel free to contact me. You can also fill out a <u>counseling form espanol</u> to request a meeting.

Welcome back! I'm excited to welcome students in the gym and see their smiling faces. Nehalem Elementary is going into their third year of having daily PE! It is recommended that kids engage in 60 minutes of physical activity per day so having 30 minutes of PE daily is instrumental in their overall well being.

I'd like to remind parents to please make sure your child has a comfortable pair of tennis shoes. Improper footwear (sandals, dress shoes, boots) can sometimes lead to injury or pose a tripping hazard. I always let students take a few minutes to change shoes if needed so keeping a pair of tennis shoes in the backpack is a great idea.

Welcome back students and families!

We are looking forward to seeing everyone again this school year. Please review the updated attached symptom tracker to see when to keep your students home. This guide is very easy to follow and should help determine when students should stay home due to illness. Also, remember students cannot carry their own medicine to school. If your student needs medicine at school, a parent or guardian needs to bring the medicine to the office and complete the paperwork. Any questions, please call the office.

PLEASE KEEP	STUDENTS WITH	SYMPTOMS	OUT OF SCHOOL

SYMPTOMS OF ILLNESS	THE STUDENT MAY RETURN AFTER *The list below tells the shortest time to stay home. A student may need to stay home longer for some illnesses.		
Fever: temperature of 100.4°F (38°C) or greater	*Fever-free for 24 hours without taking fever-reducing medicine.		
New cough illness	* Symptoms improving for 24 hours (no cough or cough is well-controlled).		
New difficulty breathing	* Symptoms improving for 24 hours (breathing comfortably). Urgent medical care may be needed.		
Diarrhea: 3 loose or watery stools in a day OR not able to control bowel movements	*Symptoms improving for 24 hours (no more than two bowel movements more than normal and no longer having accidents) OR with orders from doctor to school nurse.		
Vomiting: one or more episode that is unexplained	*Symptom-free for 24 hours OR with orders from doctor to school nurse.		
Headache with stiff neck and fever	*Symptom-free OR with orders from doctor to school nurse. Follow fever instructions above. <i>Urgent</i> medical care may be needed.		
Skin rash or open sores	*Symptom free, which means rash is gone OR sores are dry or can be completely covered by a bandage OR with orders from doctor to school nurse.		
Red eyes with colored drainage	*Symptom-free, which means redness and drainage are gone OR with orders from doctor to school nurse.		
Jaundice: new yellow color in eyes or skin	*After the school has orders from doctor or local public health authority to school nurse.		
Acting differently without a reason: unusually sleepy, grumpy, or confused.	*Symptom-free, which means return to normal behavior OR with orders from doctor to school nurse.		
Major health event, like an illness lasting 2 or more weeks OR a hospital stay, OR health condition requires more care than school staff can safely provide.	*After the school has orders from doctor to school nurse AND after measures are in place for the student's safety. Please work with school staff to address special health-care needs so the student may attend safely.		

NCRD Youth Center

Welcome Back NES students and families, we here at NCRD are happy to be back in school and hope you had a Fantastic summer! If you are in need of youth care, please reach out to us. We pick up your students at Nehalem Elementary school at the end of each school day and are open until 5pm. Our cost is \$6 a day per child. This does include a nutritious snack and a host of enrichment activities (outdoor play/walks, gym time, crafts, music, science, etc.) If interested, please reach out to Angie or Kiley at NCRD by phone, email, website, or just stop in. We are not doing drop-ins currently but hope to get back to that someday. We do have full day care when the school is closed, if it is not a national holiday. Those days are \$20 per student. The first no school day is September 23. To preregister and prepay, contact the Welcome Center. Scholarship applications are available upon request.

Scholarships for students are funded through the Friends of NCRD, who support families in need through various fundraisers throughout the year. Please let any youth center staff or the Welcome Center know if this is a need, and we will get you a scholarship application.
