PLEASE KEEP STUDENTS WITH SYMPTOMS OUT OF SCHOOL

This list is school instructions, not medical advice. Please contact your health care provider with health concerns. SYMPTOMS OF ILLNESS THE STUDENT MAY RETURN AFTER... *The list below tells the shortest time to stay home. A student may need to stay home longer for some illnesses. *Fever-free for 24 hours without taking fever-reducing Fever: temperature of 100.4°F (38°C) or greater medicine. New cough illness *Symptoms improving for 24 hours (no cough or cough New difficulty breathing *Symptoms improving for 24 hours (breathing comfortably). Urgent medical care may be needed. Diarrhea: 3 loose or watery *Symptoms improving for 24 hours (no more than two stools in a day OR not able to bowel movements more than normal and no longer having accidents) with orders from doctor to school control bowel movements nurse. Vomiting: two or more *Symptom-free for 24 hours OR with orders from episodes that are unexplained doctor to school nurse. Headache with stiff neck and *Symptom-free OR with orders from doctor to school nurse. Follow fever instructions above. > Urgent medical care may be needed. *Symptom free, which means rash is gone OR sores are Skin rash or open sores dry or can be completely covered by a bandage OR with orders from doctor to school nurse. Red eyes with colored drainage *Symptom-free, which means redness and drainage are gone OR with orders from doctor to school nurse. Jaundice: new yellow color in eyes or skin *After the school has orders from doctor or local public health authority to school nurse. Acting differently without a reason: *Symptom-free, which means return to normal unusually sleepy, grumpy, or confused. behavior OR with orders from doctor to school nurse. Major health event, like an illness lasting 2 *After the school has orders from doctor to school
