ATTENDANCE MATTERS!

We need your help! Keep your teen on track in Middle & High School.



- Chronic absence is defined as **9 days** a year— <u>even if those</u> absences are excused!
- Absenteeism in the first month of school can predict poor attendance throughout the school
 year. Half the students who miss 2-4 days in September go on to miss nearly a month of
 school.
- Dances & Social Events: Students must have **90% attendance for the 30 school days prior** to the school dance in order to attend.

Halloween Reminders

As Halloween approaches, we are excited to celebrate with a bit of festive fun! Students are encouraged to wear costumes on **October 31st**, but we ask that everyone follows these guidelines to ensure a safe and enjoyable day for all:

- 1. **School Appropriate**: Costumes must be appropriate for school and follow the general dress code. No revealing outfits, offensive language, or inappropriate images.
- 2. **Safety First:** No masks or full-face paint that completely covers the face (we need to be able to see your face clearly). Costumes should not impede movement, learning, or safety in the halls.
- 3. **No Weapons or Props**: Costumes should not include any real or fake weapons (guns, knives, swords, etc.). Props that could be used to harm others are also not allowed.
- 4. **Culturally Respectful Costumes**: Costumes should not appropriate or make fun of any race, ethnicity, culture, religion, or gender identity. Be mindful and respectful in your choices.
- 5. **Classroom Ready**: Costumes should allow students to sit at desks, participate in activities, and move safely between classes.

Honor Roll

Honor Roll/Community Service

Students who earn a 3.5 G.P.A. or better, complete 7 hours of community service/volunteer hours, have good behavior, and good attendance for the trimester will be awarded the status of Honor Roll.

HONOR ROLL

In order to make honor roll, students must complete a minimum of

7 hours of community service per trimester. For each activity, the student will need a signature and the contact information from the supervising adult. Once this is completed, send in your letter to your student's advisor or the middle school office. <u>Learn more here.</u>

Doctor's Notes for Injuries

If your student gets injured and needs to be excused from PE or have other limitations in place, we will need a doctor's note on file in the front office. This will help ensure we are following proper protocols to get your student healed up as quick as possible! Thank you for your understanding.

Immunizations

Shots are required by law for children who attend public schools, private schools, preschools, childcare facilities, and Head Start programs in Oregon. Nearly every place that provides care for a child outside the home requires shots or an exemption to stay enrolled (<u>more info</u>).

If your student is due for an immunization, you will receive a letter in the mail stating what vaccine is due. **Oregon Exclusion date for all students is Feb 25th 2026.**
